CONCERT DETAILS: Estonia


- Perform in Tallinn! with an afternoon rehearsal, and combined concert for orchestra, string orchestra, wind ensemble, and jazz ensemble!

- Present your Tallinn Concert!








DAY 4: SATURDAY, JULY 4 HELSINKI (B/D)


- · Breakfast at the hotel

- This afternoon journey across the Gulf of Finland by ferry, to the young capital of Helsinki
- Enjoy an introductory walking tour with local guides of Helsinki's center, and a visit of Helsinki Cathedral
- Dinner is served at a local restaurant or the hotel





DAY 5: SUNDAY, JULY 5 HELSINKI (B/D)

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Sightseeing continues with local guides and a visit to the singing Sibelius Monument, dedicated to Finland's beloved composer
- See historic highlights, visit the National Museum of Finland, and Temppeliaukio Church
- Prepare for your performance with a rehearsal at your venue
- Dinner at a local restaurant
- Present your Helsinki Concert!



DAY 6: MONDAY, JULY 6 ST. PETERSBURG (B/D)

- Depart by Allegro train to Russia
- Arrive in the European style city formerly known as Leningrad, and begin exploration with a locally guided panoramic tour of the city center, including a walk along the canals
- Visit Peter and Paul Cathedral, resting place of the tsars, and the Church of the Spilled Blood, where Alexander II was assassinated in 1881
- Settle into your hotel, refresh, and enjoy dinner at a local restaurant







DAY 7: TUESDAY, JULY 7 ST. PETERSBURG (B/L/D)

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Spend the day in nearby Tsarskove Selo, with a visit to the magnificent summer residence of the tsars
 Catherine Palace
- Lunch is included today
- Return to St. Petersburg and refresh
- This evening enjoy dinner at a local restaurant, and a folk show at Nikolaevsky Palace; enjoy Russian music, singers, and ballet dancers, all in the precious palace interiors
